This will be a hands on workshop so you should bring:

1. 2 or 3 freshly thrown pieces that are still attached to the bat – DO NOT WIRE THEM OFF. They can be thrown a few days in advance and kept well wrapped
2. For the sgraffito and inlaid slip design please bring some leather hard pieces
3. If you have a slip trailer that you use please bring that. Michael suggests a soft ear syringe – he will have some that he uses to show us, a hair dye bottle or check with Dennis for slip trailers.

We will be providing the slips and Michael will be sharing his recipes with us.

Michael will be bringing a number of his finished pieces to show and sell.

We will be brown bagging it for lunch.
